



Call for Papers: 2020 Annual Meeting, St. Louis Missouri

Proposals must include a 150-250-word description of the presentation and the following: title of the presentation, name of the presenter, institutional affiliation (where appropriate), email address, phone contact, and a brief CV. Proposals must be received by May 15, 2020. Presenters who are selected will be notified by June 1, 2020.
